

## **PISC Year Long Tournament Rules**

- All entrants must be a paid member of the Plum Island Surfcasters for the current year prior to entering a fish.
- This event will run from April 1st December 31st.
  - Regular tournament will run from April1st -October 31<sup>st</sup>, with awards given in November.
  - •Exotics will run from April 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup>. Species include Spanish Mackerel, Bonito and False Albacore. Length for both kept and released fish will determine the winners. Awards to be given in November.
  - Die Hard tournament will run from Nov. 1-Dec. 31st with awards given the following January at the general meeting.
- Species will include Striped Bass and Bluefish only for regular and Die Hard tournament.
- The categories for the Regular and Die Hard tournaments are as follows: (C&R: Catch & Release)
  - > Striper from Plum Island (C&R only)
  - > Striper from Surf (Kept)
  - > Striper from Surf (C&R)
  - > Striper from Boat (Kept)
  - > Striper from Boat (C&R)
  - > Striper on Fly (Kept)
  - > Striper on Fly (C&R)
  - ➤ Blue from Surf (Kept or released)
  - ➤ Blue from Boat (Kept or released)
  - ➤ Blue on Fly (Kept or released)
  - Note: Length of Bluefish will determine the winner. Length must be from end of snout to the fork of the tail.
- There will also be awards in each of these categories for Juniors (17 and under).
- There are no geographical boundaries for this tournament.
- (Except Striper from Plum Island must be from Plum Island)
- Awards will be given for the HEAVIEST fish in each "Kept" category and for LONGEST fish in each C&R category. Fish must be weighed on a certified scale (many tackle shops have scales available). Entry form must be signed by weigh station in all Kept categories. Fish caught and released must have a witness signature on the form unless fish are released based on the Catch, Photo and Release criteria (see below).

- Entries should be completed using the club web page or using the club entry form. Slips must include the following information:

## Species

- Senior or Junior
- > Weight for kept fish
- Length for released fish
- Name and phone number of entrant
- > Date of catch
- > Time of catch
- > Date of submission
- > Name and location of weigh station
- > Surf or Boat caught
- > Name of witness
- Witness signature
- \*Photograph for each C&R fish if no witness. See club web pages for details on how to enter a catch and release fish when there is no witness.
- Awards will be given for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each category for regular tournament. Awards will be given for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each category for Exotics tournament. Longest fish only.
- Die Hard tournament will only award first place per category.
- Any angler may only hold one place at a time per category.
- Slips must be submitted within 30-days of being caught. Slips must be submitted no later than 3-days after the end date of the tournament. If mailed in the post mark date will be used.
- Slips must be turned in to the tournament director, (see board web page), either by mail,
- Emailed, using the online form on the club web page or at the monthly meeting.
- We will have a monthly drawing and award for fish entered during each month. Any member who submits a fish for entry in the yearlong or exotics will have their name entered. A members name will only be entered once per month. For seniors all stripers entered must be 28" or greater. Juniors may enter any size striper.
- All tie breakers will be determined by the day slip was received
- Second tie breaker determined by day and time fish was caught
- **All** decisions are final.
